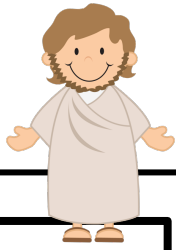


SEPTEMBER At SBC Kids

ACTIVITY 1

Spy Out the Land

Grab two empty toilet paper rolls and string or yarn to make binoculars. Pretend you are going to spy out the land of Canaan. Discuss what you would see, how you would feel about it, and what sort of response you would have. Use this to discuss how we can always trust God even in times of uncertainty.

ACTIVITY 2

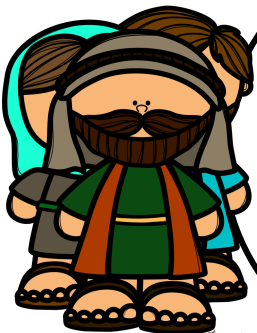
Memorize Scripture

2. Write the verse on a white board. Each time you say the verse, choose a word to erase until there are no words left.
3. Write the verse in big words on notecards. Scramble the words then work to put them in order.
